Town of Danby Transfer Station

Transfer stickers are required on household trash bags. Stickers are available at the Town Office or at the Transfer Station. The cost is \$1.00 per sticker.

There is no charge for recycling.

HOURS: The Transfer Station is open Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday from 7:00AM to 4:00PM.



ZERO-SORT RECYCLING – ACCEPTED ITEMS:

- Glass and aluminum bottles and cans rinsed clean
- Boxboard and corrugated cardboard cereal, shoe, dry food boxes, packing boxes, paper egg cartons
- Envelopes, mail, white and colored paper folders, cards, flyers
- Magazines, newspapers, soft covered books (phone books, catalogs)
- Plastics #1 7 and rigid plastics milk jugs, cleaning product containers, detergents, dairy and food tubs (sour cream, yogurt, etc.), frozen food trays

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS FOR ZERO-SORT RECYCLING

- No light bulbs, pyrex, drinking glasses, windows, ceramics
- No paint, paint cleaners, automotive sprays, or other hazardous fluids
- No oil filters or scrap metals
- No Tyvek or plastic envelopes, bags with plastic inserts, or pellet bags
- No bubble wrap or foam packing materials
- No pliable plastic (grocery, produce bags) or styrofoam containers

HOUSEHOLD TRASH FEES per bag size:

13 Gallon tall kitchen or smaller requires: **1** sticker \$1.00 30-39 Gallon Large trash requires: **2** stickers \$2.00 45-55 Gallon contractor type requires: **4** stickers \$4.00



TOWN OF DANBY NOTICE January 14, 2021

Due to limited space and safety reasons effectively immediately the Town of Danby Transfer Station can receive only the following items:

- Household garbage/trash in plastic bags
- Recyclable materials must be loose or in a clear bag for inspection
- Food Scraps NO Bags, only scraps go in the container.

The Town will no longer accept the following items.

- Electronic Waste (computers, televisions, etc...)
- Light Bulbs
- Bulk Items (mattresses, tables, chairs, etc...)
- Metals You may take Electronics, Light Bulbs, Bulk Items and Metals to the Gleason Road Transfer Station in Rutland or Hubbards at 1678 Cold River Road in North Clarendon. Or, you may bring them to Casellas at 310 Tennis Way in East Dorset. Alternatively, you may store them at home and bring them to the Town per public notice on one of our Dump Days when we will be able to handle those materials.
