 - Project updates
 - Flower Brook Water Shed
 - Sediment coming out of head waters
 - Walked the stream
 - Observed sliding of sediment
 - Glacier till area, dropped parts of rocks and particles
 - On the small scale compared to other similar watersheds
 - It is possible to stabilize some portions of it
 - Doesn't want to propose projects unless funding is available
 - A lot of land was cleared
 - Leave trees that fall in the stream
 - Help with holding sediment back
 - Some areas would be safe to leave them in and other areas could contribute to more damage down the line

- Marble in the past has been used to help line some water ways to assist in sediment retention
- Potential culvert projects that could qualify for funding projects
 - Land and Water Conservation Fund
- Flower Brook Bridge
 - Coming from the fish conservation area
 - Concern about losing the pool of water available for the fire department
- o Revisit parts of the plan that Hillary can assist with clean water projects
 - Set something up for the spring

 - Would like more community input
 - Encouraged to do the survey that they have available on their website
- o RRPC Update Drea Stoddard
 - RRPC approved a new structure for town member dues
 - Used to be flat rate of \$1000
 - Now is based off \$1.00 per capita per town
 - o \$1284 would be Danby's amount due
 - Compared to other regional planning commissions to come up with a new formula
 - Adds to the RRPC budget
 - o Cost of everything has gone up and new staff members etc.
 - Greg Poelker-McKee
 - Received a grant from Workforce Opportunities for Rural Communities (WORC) \$1.25 million
 - Help support career pathways for high school students not college bound
 - Is it a multiyear grant with hopes to lay the groundwork for the program to continue after the grant funding
 - Very new and will hopefully get more information at the next RRPC meeting
